

The Distance to which Sound may be Propagated. The distance to which sound may be propagated does not admit of precise measurement. In general, it may be stated, a sound will be heard further the greater the intensity of the sound, and the denser the medium through which it is propagated. It also depends greatly upon the delicacy of hearing of different individuals. The intensity of a sound, like that of all forces acting in lines, diminishes in the inverse ratio of the squares of distances of the sounding body. Thus if the linear dimensions of a theatre be doubled, the volume of the performers' voices as any part of the circumference will be diminished in a fourth proportion.

The powerful human voice in the open air, at the ordinary temperature, is audible at the distance of seven hundred feet. In a frosty air, and undisturbed by winds or current, sound is heard at a much greater distance with surprising distinctness. Lieutenant Foster, in the third Polar expedition of Captain Parry, held a conversation with a man across the harbor of Fort Bowen, a distance of nearly a mile and a quarter.

Dr. Young states, on the authority of Derham, that the watchword "all's well" had been distinctly heard from old to new Gibraltar, a distance of ten miles. The marching of a company of soldiers may be heard on a still night at from five hundred and eighty to eight hundred and thirty paces; at eighty paces, at foot pace, at seven hundred and fifty paces distant. When the air is calm and dry, the report of a musket is audible at one thousand paces. The sound of the cannonading at Waterloo was heard at Dover.

Sounds travel further and more loudly on the earth's surface than through the atmosphere. Thus it is said that the signal of Antwerp in 1822, the cannonading was heard in the distance of nearly three hundred and twenty miles distant; the cannonading at the battle of Jena was heard feebly in the open fields of Jena, but in the casemates of the fortifications it was heard with great distinctness. The noise of the sea fight between the English and Dutch in 1672 was heard at Shrewsbury, a distance of two hundred miles; the greatest known distance to which sound has been carried by the atmosphere is three hundred and forty miles; as it is asserted, that the very violent explosions of the volcano at St. Vincent's have been heard at Demerara.—*Physics and Philosophy, by Prof. William Brewster.*

Advantages of Shade Trees. A correspondent of the Rural New Yorker thinks the forest-trees of our country are sadly wasted, and calls upon Congress and the President to stop the system of throwing new lands into market to be run over and half cultivated, to the great injury of true improvement, and incuring great expense and unnecessary hardship. He thinks that use could be found for all timber-land, buildings, fences, &c., or for charcoal, which is an endless and imperishable source of wealth and nourishment.

A single row of shade trees on the sides of the street, in a small village, will make \$1,000 of real estate worth \$1,100 in five years. A dozen trees, such as box-elder, locust, &c., with a half dozen watered evergreens, judiciously arranged about a farm house, will add \$5 per acre to the price of a hundred acres. A very ordinary house may be made very respectable by a neat yard well stocked with trees. Many crops of fire-wood may be saved by a grove of evergreens; and other trees on the windward side of a house, screened by a single row of maples, will cool by 17 degrees in a hot day than another room similarly situated except the maples. In case of fires, green trees protect buildings from flames raging near by and also afford great shelter to the firemen.

It may be late in the season to transplant trees, though it is early enough for evergreens, but it may not be too late to protect trees already planted from cattle, horses, &c., and without protection they will better remain in the forest or nursery.

Important as these considerations certainly are, in reference to shade and ornamental trees, there is the more significant inquiry, what is to become of our forests? The failure of springs and streams, the terrible force of the winds, the unusual severity of the winters, and in many places prospective barrenness, all in consequence of the loss of our forests, should induce efforts to stay the desolation. If farmers could be persuaded that they could produce as much from fifty acres well tilled, as from a hundred indifferently managed, would they not be willing to till the fifty and devote the balance to trees? They also benefit the birds, to make melody and kill off the insects gratis. In selecting trees, those which are clear and hardy, and do not throw up roots, should be chosen; none should be placed so near a fence or any building as to keep it damp, or to prevent the sun from touching it during some part of the day; and air should always have been allowed to circulate around both trees and buildings, to make them healthier and longer-lived.

PROVE THE HAY-CAPS.—This valuable improvement still fails to receive that attention which it deserves. We have already written so much upon the subject that we need not repeat it now. We will say, however, that the great advantages resulting from their use. They may be cheaply and quickly made of coarse cotton, 15 to 20 yards square, roughly hemmed, and provided with loops at each corner for stakes, or stones sewed in to the corners, as weights to keep them from blowing off. A quantity of these always at hand to throw over cocks of uncurd or cured hay, when a storm comes up, will not suffer the hay to be blown away, and on a single occasion, while they will be used for many years—not only to cover hay, but grain left in the field. A full description of them, with illustrations, was given last July (see vol. 47, p. 207). We have usually advised farmers to make them at home, but many will not take even the slight trouble required for this advice, would had the attention of such to the advertisements in our last, and make up a large scale, and send reasonable to some manufacturers and prepare the cloth so as to be water-proof, and still open enough to let the steam to evaporate through them, we think it may be quite as economical to purchase those ready-made, as to make them at home—that is, where they are on sale at a great saving. But, however you proceed, let us again urge all hay makers, who have not done so, to make the experiment of using a few hay-caps this year. They will not be abandoned after one trial.—*The Agriculturalist.*
