CANAL Commissioners.—We note that our Democratic exchanges in this State are engaged in bringing into the field their favorite candidates for Canal Commissioners, and offering their respective claims. Gamble, Esq., of Lexington—also a gentleman, and either of whom would make a capital man, if nominated. From Harrisburg.

In our last we privately printed a report on the proceedings of the Legislature; but, on account of the reports we really can find nothing to add to what we have already given that is worth repeating. As yet little has been done except the organization and election of officers. Prior to the completion of the North Branch Canal, we note, are being put in great profusion. A resolution having a committee to investigate the character and condition of the various Banks and Savings Institutions, and, about to ask, renewals of their charters, were, by the Wings, laid on the table in the Senate on Friday.

The return of the Late election for Congress were opened on the 12th inst., from which it appears that Wm. F. Johnston had a majority of 297 votes.

A correspondent of the Pennsylvania under date of Friday, writes as follows: "While petitions are pouring into the Legislature for the recharter of old, and the charter of new Banks, there is not a little dissatisfaction on the part of the Wings' representatives, in regard to those parts of the Governor's Message which refer to Banking institutions."

"That a live Wing Governor should recommend addition to their pet corporations has annoyed his friends; and while many of them shake their heads, as it were, as expressed in his message, on the subject, are all wrong. Others think his language is to be taken in a Philadelphian sense, and that the Banks will get all they ask for. Meanwhile, Bank-bors are gathering in, and the existing subject of Banks and Corporations will come up, and be discussed all over the State."
