

The Launch of the Steamers. The great event of the morning was the launch of the three masted schooner, the *Irwin*, of 500 tons, built at the yard of Wm. H. Boston, from the shipyard of Wm. H. Boston, foot of Twelfth street, East River.

The spectacle, which was one of the most imposing of its kind ever witnessed in the city, drew together, as might be expected, an immense concourse of spectators. Notwithstanding the early hour at which it took place, when most persons are occupied with their business affairs, there could not have been less than 20,000 people present.

Every place at which it was possible to obtain a glimpse of the novel and interesting scene, was crowded with well-dressed spectators, among whom were many ladies—some who had come to their carriage, which were standing thickly in the adjacent streets and yards.

Every point of view presented a magnificent spectacle, in all the craft in the vicinity, including the splendid hull of the *Atlantic*, at Stillman's yard, presented immense masses of heads, forming a coup d'oeil of surprising interest.

About half past nine the Steamer "Boston" was launched, and the *Irwin* was launched. This vessel, which is of small draft, is intended to ply upon the Sacramento river; she presents a beautiful figure, and seems admirably adapted for the purpose for which she is designed.

Shortly afterwards, the "New World," fully rigged, with all her machinery complete, and steam up, rushed into her native element, amidst the cheers of the populace.

This is the first instance, we believe, in which a steamer fully equipped and ready for sea, has been launched. There were a large number of invited guests on board; and she took her departure down the river on her first trial trip.

After a brief interval, all eyes were eagerly turned towards the great steamship *Arctic*. It was only a few minutes that she was upon the stocks to the height of an ordinary house. Viewed at whatever point, the eye was delighted with the symmetry and beauty of her proportions; and it was only by comparing her with others, that it was possible to form an adequate idea of her gigantic size.

She is the most stupendous vessel ever constructed in the United States of North America. This being one of the new line of Liverpool steamships, has invested it with an ordinary degree of interest to all classes of the community, and we cannot but be gratified that the enterprise, so bold and the skillful architect, may meet with their reward in the entire success of their splendid undertaking.

Notwithstanding such immense masses of people had convened on the occasion, we have not been able to learn that a single accident transpired.—N. Y. Era. Post.
