

PROCLAMATION. In pursuance of an act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, entitled "An Act relating to the Elections of the Commonwealth," approved the second day of July, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two...

Also, that in the 61st section of said act, it enacted that "every general and special election shall be opened between EIGHT AND TEN in the forenoon, and shall continue without interruption or adjournment until SEVEN o'clock in the evening, when the polls shall be closed."
