**FACTS ABOUT MILK.**—Cream cannot rise through a great depth of milk. If, therefore, milk is desired to retain its cream for a time, it should be put into a deep, narrow can; but if it is desired to keep it most completely cream, it should be poured into a broad, flat dish, not much exceeding one inch in depth. The evolution of cream is facilitated by a rise, and retarded by a depression of temperature. At the usual temperature of the dairy—fifty degrees of Fahrenheit—all the cream will probably rise in thirty-six hours; but at seventy degrees it will perhaps rise half that time; and when the milk is kept near the freezing point, the cream will rise very slowly, because it becomes solidified.

In wet and cold weather the milk is less rich than in dry and warm, and in this account more cheese is obtained in cold than in warm, though not in thundery weather. The season has its effects. The milk, in spring, is supposed to be the best for drinking; hence it would be best for calves; in summer it is best suited for cheese; and in autumn the butter for keeping is better than that of summer—the cows lose frequently milked, give richer milk; and consequently more butter. The morning's milk is richer than the evening's. The last drawn milk of each milking, at all times and seasons, is richer than the first drawn, which is the poorest. *Western Agriculturist.*

**A VALUABLE PAINT.**—Take common clay, the same that common bricks are made of, dry, pulverize, and run through a sieve, and mix with linseed oil. You have then, a first rate fire-proof paint, of a delicate drab color. Put it on as thick as you can, and it will be as good as any other. If any one has any doubts on the subject, let him try it on a small scale—paint a shingle for instance, and let it dry. Recollect that it must be mixed thicker than common paint.

The clay, when first dug, be wet or damp, but will soon dry, spread in the air, under shelter, or if wanted immediately, it may be dried in a kettle over the fire. When dry it will be in lumps, and can be pulverized by placing in an iron kettle a few inches in the ground, and pounding it with a billet of hard wood three inches in diameter, three feet long, the lower end rounded off a little, &c. Then sift. Any clay will make paint, but the colors may differ, which can easily be ascertained by trying it on a small scale as above indicated. By burning the clay slightly, you get a light red, and the greater the heat, the more red, and the brighter or deeper the red. *Country Gent.*

**POULTRY AND THEIR DRESS.**—To promote the laying of your hens in winter, feed them twice a day with grain, alternately between corn, oats, and buckwheat—two or three times a week, give them messes of fresh meat or fresh fish, except very fine. Keep under cover; always accessible to them, old mortar, chalk broke fine, or lime, that has been slack—oyster-shell fine is best—or bones finely pulverized—also, sand and ashes for the hens to dust themselves in. Water them three times a day.

Clear out your poultry house three times a week, put the dung in a barrel, cover it with a slight covering of earth, and sprinkling of plaster—keep the barrel in a dry place, and every five barrels of dung thus preserved will be sufficient manure to grow you fifty bushels of corn or more. *American Farmer.*

**NICE PANCAKES FOR SUPPER.**—These are made of eggs, flour, and milk. The just proportions are tablespoonful of flour to each egg. To make small pancakes, beat a couple of eggs thoroughly, and add sweet milk. Then take a couple of tablespoonfuls of flour, work into it this paste and double butter by adding the milk and eggs, and a little salt.

Grease the pan with a piece of sweet lard or butter, and stir briskly to prevent adhering to the bottom. When the under side is sufficiently browned turn it. Leave the cakes folded, with sugar or honey, and butter between the folds, or sugar alone. If this be found to be so solid, add more eggs and use less flour. A slight sprinkle of grated nutmeg will be an addition. *Maine Farmer.*

**SELLING CORN.**—The following remarks in regard to selling corn in the ear, we clip from the *American Farmer*:

"Don't sell your corn on the ears but shell it before disposing of it. By doing so you'll have the freight which would have to pay for the cobs, if you sold it on the cobs, besides the cobs to have ground into meal, which, when thus prepared, if mixed with cut straw and hay, makes most excellent food for cattle; half a peck of cob meal, two quarts of corn meal, and half a bushel of cut hay or straw, makes an admirable meal, being brought into the shop by the addition of hot water for a milk corn."

**EGG DUMPLINGS.**—Make a batter of a pint of milk, two well-beaten eggs, a salt-spoonful of salt, and four enough to make a batter as thick as for pondcake; have a clean saucepan of boiling water; let the water boil fast, drop in the batter by the tablespoonful; four or five minutes will boil them. Take them with a skimmer on to a dish, put a bit of butter and pepper over, and serve with boiled or cold meat. For a little dessert, put butter and grated nutmeg, with syrup or sugar over. *Maine Farmer.*

**QUESTIONS FOR THE TABLE.**—We know from personal observation, that few persons are acquainted with the best method of preparing questions for the table. It is simply this:—Make them, remove the skin, slice and serve them with cream and sugar. If you have never eaten them prepared in this way, try it by all means, and you will thank us for the suggestion. So says the *Farmer's Mirror*.

**THE MEADOWS OF AMERICA.**—Gov. Wright of Indiana, says that our grass crop is not properly appreciated. No crop, he says, approaches so near spontaneous richness, and is so easily raised. The last crop of the United States, in 1850, he estimates at 13,000,000 tons; that for 1855 he estimates at 15,000,000 tons, which is worth \$150,000,000, while the whole cotton crop is valued at only \$128,000,000. Of this crop more than half is produced by the four States—N. York, which yields one-fourth of the whole, Ohio, Indiana and Illinois. The grass crop which is used for pasturage is, at least, as valuable; and the hay crop, which is annually over \$300,000,000. Few people will believe that the grass crop of New York State is worth more than its wheat, and yet statistics show that such is the fact.
