The steamship Golden Gate, which left San Francisco July 21 for Panama, with 300 passengers, \$1,144,000 in treasure for New York and \$270,000 for England, was burned at sea July 27th, and all the passengers and crew were rescued.

Washington Pennsylvania Soldiers' Relief Association.

Under date of the 15th, it is ordered, 1st, that no person subject to be drafted, shall be allowed to leave the country, on pain of arrest, &c.
Second—Any person liable to draft who shall absent himself from his county or State before such draft is made, will be arrested by any Provost Marshal or other United States or State officer, wherever he may be found within the jurisdiction of the United States, and conveyed to the nearest military port or depot, and placed in military duty for the term of the draft, and the expenses of his own arrest and conveyance to such port or depot; and also the sum of five dollars as a reward to the officer who shall make such arrest, shall be deducted from his pay.
