Revenue Law，is published for the infor

［Sec．32．And be it further enacted
 otherwise dispose of，any empty cigar
box or boxes which have been sarped，
vilhont first defacing or destroving euch wox or boxes which have beeo starpea，
withont first defacing or destroying euch
stampa，or shall refill any cigar box wich at first destroying such stamp，fall on
conviction of either offence be liable to penalty of oue huydred dollars or to im－
prisonment not exceeding sixty daye，or both，in the discretion of the chart，with
the costs of the trial，and it shall be law ful for any cigar inspector or．revenue off cer to destroy any empty cigar box ap
which a cigar stamp shall te fond．］
