Shocking Tragedy!

MURDER AND SUICIDE IN EAST BRIDGEWATER.

Perhaps the most terrible affair that ever occurred in this county, or this section of the State, is recorded below.

On his breast was a wound surrounded by a mass of gore, and at his feet lay his rifle with empty barrel, and by his side an iron rod three inches long, bent at one end.

The deceased was 58 years of age in June last, and had been married about three years, his wife being 25 years younger than himself.

On an examination, a transverse cut, 2 1/2 inches in length, was found at the back of the head, at the base of the skull, and another cut three-fourths of an inch in length, just back of the right ear, also bruises on the shoulders, head, and neck.

On Saturday Coroner Halsey held inquests on both bodies, and on the examination of witnesses the following facts were elicited:
