what was bad. A portion was left for a time, and then sowed in a hurry, the man having time only to give a thin dash of earth over them. These came up profusely, and the reputation of the seedman was rescued. The rule which we have adop-ted for beds in open ground is to cover all seed from three to five times their shorter diemeter-small seed receiving only a slight sprinkling, and larger a more copious sifting of the fine mould. No seed should be sown when the soil is not dry enough to be reduced to fine powder. The best soil is sandy loam, but now it is a larger proportion of clay makes a good material if dry enough to be made per-fectly mellow. The addition of sand and leaf mould will make any soil of proper consistency. The best way to sow seeds is in the first place in drills or circles; then the weeds may be easily taken out. If sown broadcast, it will be more difficult to keep the bed clean. Provide a quanti-ty of finely pulverized mould in a basket er barrow, and cover them by sprinkling it evenly over with the hand. Avoid soaking the beds with water until the plants are up. If the surface is likely to become too dry after sowing, which is ofbecome too dry after sowing, which is of-ten the case, put on a thin gauzy mulch-ing. This may be pulverized moss, thin canvase, or even a newspapers. Every person who plants a flower garden should know the hardy plants, which usually come on soor, and may be sown early, from the tender, which are often more tardy in appearing, and should be sown later. Most seed catalogues designate these separately. these separately.

Souring Gate, How will it do to plow in oats instead of harrowing? The ground had potatoer last summer, and the soil is light. Will a sowing of leached ashes do any good, and at what time in the season? How will cats succeed sown after the cats of last year? H. H. Weschester county, New York. [Unless the plowing is very shallow, the seed will be buried too deep. to come up well. If the ground is clean to come up well. If the ground is clean and mellow, a gang plow running furrows 3 inches deep, would cover the cats well. But if the soil is not mellow; it will be likely to break up more or less into clods and the seed would germinate much bettor by pulverizing well with the harrow. Oats will not do well after cats as on fresh ground, although on very strong laud the second crop sometimes is not much diminished. Leached ashes are good on nearly all soils, but do more good on some nearly all soils, but do more good on some. others, according to trial; the best time to sow the ashes is after plowing and before harrowing .- Country Gentleman.
