ANOTHER FLAMING PROCLAMATION FROM GAMBETTA. TOURS, Oct. 14.—Gambetta has issued the following proclamation:

Here is the bulletin of their first victory! On the entire zone around the city the Prussians have been driven out of all the position which they had been occupying for three weeks towards St. Denis.

I invite the provinces to do their duty as Paris has done hers. Vive Paris! Vive la France! Vive La Republique!

He informed me that he made his escape from Capreza in a fishing smack provided by his friend Col. Boudine, who accompanied him.

After expressing a determination to remain with the French to the last, he added: "Why will not the noble American Republic, the glory and admiration of all free peoples, send material aid to the young and struggling Republic of France?"
