ADDRESS OF WELCOME TO THE TEACHERS OF JUNIATA COUNTY.

TEACHERS AND FRIENDS OF EDUCATION.—It is no new thing for you thus to assemble in this county for mutual improvement.

Here permit me once more and for the last time as your presiding officer to congratulate you and bid you well come to your county seat...

A retrospect of the educational events of the county for the last few years has afforded to me much satisfaction and I trust it will not, at this time, prove entirely uninteresting to many of you...

There was paid last year, that is in 1870, for instruction alone in Juniata county, \$14,776.36, and in 1869 there was paid for the same purpose \$14,171.27, showing an increase in the teachers' salaries in one year of \$605.09.

Twenty-four school houses were built during the last five years, and if we add to their cost new seating, repainting, &c., we shall have the handsome sum of \$43,751.42, that the tax-payers of the county have paid in five years for school houses alone.
