PROFITS OF HONEY.

At a recent convention of bee culturists. held in Cleveland, Ohio, some statistics of the profits of honey raising were elicited which were rather amazing. For instance, Mr. Quimby, a noted beeraiser at St. Joneville, N. Y., had 12,000 pounds of surplus honeyfrom 300 swarms Of box honey the largest yield was over 200 pounds. This honey was of the very best quality, being made from white clover blossoms. THE FRANKLIN CREAMERY. This is probably the largest creamery in New York State. At present, the milk of eight hundred and fitty cows is handled every day. One day last mouth the creamery turned out one thousand two hundred and eighty eight pounds of batter, and one thousand five bundred pounds of cheese; one ton of cheese and seven hundred and seventy five pounds; of butter per day is the ordinary work The average amount of milk received darly is twenty thousand nine hundred and

eighty-one pounds. It is located in Franklin, selar re Co , four miles from the line of the Albany and Susquehanna Railroad. The building is nicely fluished, thirty-eight by sixty feet, with a wing twenty-eight by forty four feet; two stories high, and in a part three stories high, with rooms for dwelling; water vat room for rising cream, twenty-four by thirty-eight feet; four six hundred gallon cheese vats, thirs ty presses, sixteen churns, carried by a

stx horse power portable machine. It was established in the spring of 1867, and is now operating on its fourth season. Butter and cheese is manufac tured by the pound, at three cents for butter and two cents for cheese, and patrone pay all expenses for packages, salt. &c., for butter; boxes, bandages, annetto, &c . for cheese. The net proceeds to the patrous have compared favorably with the other system of dairying, and it will probably continue to do so, unless the system should become so general as to over-supply the summer market for but ter, and flood the country with too many

skimmed cheeses, which is quite likely

to happen .- N. Y. Observer. In a few minutes the pain will be allayed and recovery proceeds rapidly. In my own case a rusty nail had made a bad wound in the bottom of my foot. The pain and nervous irritation was severe. This was all removed by holding it in the smoke for fifteen minutes, and I was able to resume my reading in comfort. We have often recommended it to others with like results Last week one of my men had a finger nail torn out by a pair of ice tongs. It became very painful as was to have been expected Held in sugar smoke for twenty minutes, the pain ceased, and it promises speedy

recovery. WHAT Washington knew about farming was worth knowing. In 1787 be had five hundred and eighty acres in grass; sowed six hundred bushels of oats seven hundred acres of wheat, and as much more in corn, barley, potatoes, beans, peas, &c., and one hundred and fifty with turnlps. He constantly employed two hundred and fifty hands, and kept twenty-four plows going during the whole year, when the earth and the state of the weather would permit. In 1780 he slaughtered one hundred and fifty hogs for the use of his own family, and provisions for his negroes.
