SHEEP AS A RENOVATOR.

Many writers on agriculture are now of the opinion that sheep are as profitable stock as can be kept upon a farm.

The old notion that sheep are a scourge on a farm, is giving place to its opposite, that they are a renovator and a blessing, and particularly profitable to a poor farm.

The writer goes on to say that he was a Southern rebel—came home a d d b r k to a small worn-out farm.

He bought in the fall of one year, ten ewes, for \$20, put them into a small field, full of nothing but briars and weeds.

They soon ate up all the briars and trampled down the weeds. He fed them through the winter on swamp hay, turnips, beets and a little meal or shorts.

They thrived well, had thirteen lambs in the spring worth the price of the old ones, while the wool and manure more than paid him for the cost of the feed.

That field he put in with corn, and raised thirty to thirty-five bushels of good corn per acre, whereas, before the sheep had manured it, it would scarcely have raised the seed.

His success gave him the cue upon which to set, and now he has a fine flock of sheep, and his whole farm is much improved. Who will not say this is better even than superphosphates or guano!

Make Your Trees Branch Low. Train your pear trees for garden or field use so that they will branch at a distance of one or two feet from the ground.

The advantages are easily enumerated: 1. It is easy to train.

2. It is easy to gather the fruit. 3. Falling fruit is little injured.

4. All branches being sturdy will not be broken by wind or snow. 5. Fruit will be kept shaded and moist.

6. The trunk will be protected from the recording sun. 7. The tree will grow more and more beautiful.—Horticulturist.

Veracity in Horses. A subscriber to the Herald and Horse who has a horse thin in flesh, but with an enormous appetite, which prompts him to eat the litter, asks what to do about it.

This inordinate appetite is a symptom of disease in the digestive organs, or of the presence of worms. If no worms have been observed, the first may be supposed to be the cause. A simple remedy is to feed to the horse a handful of wood ashes, one ounce of sulphur, an ounce of common salt, mixed in his feed every other day.

Simple Cure for Rheumatism. The Quinine fringes the following as a cure for this painful disease: "Boil a small potato of potatoes, and bathe the part affected with the water in which the potatoes were boiled, as hot as can be applied immediately before going to bed. The pain will be removed, or at least alleviated, by the next morning. Some of the most obstinate pains have lately been cured by an application of this novel and simple remedy."

A STANDING antidote for poison by oak, ivy, etc., is to take a handful of quick lime, dissolved in water, let it stand half an hour, then pour the poisoned parts with it. Three or four applications will never fail to cure the most aggravated cases. Poison from bees, hornets, spider bites, etc., are instantly arrested by the application of equal parts of common salt and bicarbonate of soda, well rubbed on the place bitten or stung.

TO DESTROY AND KEEP BEES AWAY.—One ounce of quicksilver and the white of three eggs well mixed by heating, in the way eggs are beat, with a knife or spoon, and applied an inch around the knobs, and other infested parts, with a feather or brush, will keep the unwelcome bed-fellows away from two to three years. The greatest difficulty is to get the two articles to mix, but perseverance will overcome that difficulty.

FOR A SPRAIN.—Wet the injured part with a flannel dipped in hot water, or if the sprain be very painful, wet the flannel with laudanum and cover the whole with a dry cloth. Then, with the arm in a sling if it be the wrist that is sprained, or the leg in a horizontal position if it be the ankle, wait and see if it be necessary to send for a doctor.

TO MAKE HARD WATER SOFT.—Take one ounce of fresh lime and stir it well in a bucket of water, then stir all thoroughly in a barrel of water, and as soon as it settles, the water will be soft and fit for use, as it will drive all impurities to the bottom. River water, when muddy, is better to drink by this process.

WATERPROOF OIL BLACKING.—In one pint of alcohol put as much gum camphor as will dissolve, then into this put all the India rubber that will dissolve, one pint carrier's oil, six pounds of tallow, and two ounces lampblack. Mix all these with heat.

COLD IN HEAD.—One teaspoonful of pine tar and one of pulverized sulphur burnt, and the fumes inhaled, will almost immediately cure a cold in the head.
