WEEKLY REVIEW OF THE MARKETS. OFFICE OF THE POST. PITTSBURGH, August 6, 1887. REMARKS: Business during the past week has not been remarkably active, but prices have been firm and sales steady.

GRAIN—Sales at 4:00 p.m. Coffee—Sales at 4:00 p.m. HAY—Sales at 4:00 p.m. HIDES—For green 23 cents paid by tanners, red sales at 4:00 p.m. LEATHER—Baltimore sole sells at 130¢.

Wool—The price of this article appears to be the same as our last week's quotation. Sales to the extent of 20,000 lbs. made during the week at the following rates: Common, 23¢; 2d, 21¢; 3d, 19¢.

Flour—The sales of the week have been much larger than the week previous. We present below each week's operations, in this way our weekly readers can form a better idea of what has been going on.

Monday—The foreign wheat received per steamer Washington, had an improved effect upon the flour market on Saturday. Holders asked an advance of 25 cents on each barrel, and readily obtained it. The sales were very light, and light stocks on hand, and confidence principally dry loads to light consumers.

Tuesday—There was nothing new in the market yesterday. The foreign wheat, which was introduced in the forenoon, produced no change in prices. The truth is, little is arriving, and the stock on hand is not much larger than it is necessary for the immediate home demand.

Friday—There were more buyers than sellers in the market yesterday. Very little arrived, and holders appeared independent to part with the article. We report sales of 60 bbls. at \$4.50 per bbl. (prime) delivered at \$4.50 per bbl. Sales by the dry load at \$4.62 per bbl. Single bbls. from store at \$4.75 per bbl.
