**TROUBLE AMONG THE VOLUNTEERS!**

**STILL LATER FROM GEN. SCOTT**  
WASHINGTON, Sept. 14, 10 o'clock, P. M.  
The government dispatches have this morning been received at Washington, by express.  
The news heretofore received has been fully confirmed.  
On the night of the 20th, the American forces, consisting of 7000 men, met the army of Charbono, a division of 3 or 4 miles from the Mexican camp.  
The Mexicans were 22,000 strong, and were entrenched behind an immense battery of heavy artillery.  
After two hours of bloody conflict, our gallant troops swept everything before them, mainly at the point of the bayonet!

The American loss is estimated at 1000—mostly less than that number.  
The Mexican loss, about 3000, among whom are numbered many of the most distinguished officers and soldiers in the army, gentlemen and civilians.  
The armistice was agreed upon, and five commissioners were agreed upon, at the head of whom were Mr. Taylor and Mr. Clayton.  
They had two meetings, and were to hold a third on Monday, August 30.  
Valenciana ceased with two companies of Tobacco, and proceeded against Santa Anna and peace.
