CHOLERA IN ST. LOUIS.

For the last four days the reports of instances of the victims of Cholera have indicated a gradual and steady decline in the mortality. The official accounts of yesterday, the 9th, show the Cholera to have been 101, as reported by nine out of the thirteen committees.

It is generally supposed that the reports for yesterday will exhibit an increase of the disease. The number of deaths reported yesterday was 101, as reported by nine out of the thirteen committees.

The reports of instances for yesterday seem to be partial and unreliable. The sections of the several committees having grown careless about making returns, but the number of deaths is probably one hundred.

The disease appears to be now rising among the better conditioned classes of our citizens. One epidemic is much reduced by the flight of citizens from the presence of the pestilence.

Pierre Chouteau, one of the early settlers, and the last survivor of the LaSalle party, died yesterday at the advanced age of 91.

Seven coffins, containing dead bodies were found in Chouteau's Park, placed there no doubt because of the difficulty of obtaining promptly the means of conveyance to the burial ground.

Full returns of the instances yesterday report 190 deaths, of which 150 were from Cholera. The weather was very warm.

CHOLERA IN CINCINNATI. Cincinnati, July 11th. Instances from Cholera today were 75, or diseases 50. Treatment in Cholera Hospital under Electric Physicians has been very successful.

There were received and under treatment yesterday, 26. Admissions, 5; deaths, 2; discharged, 7.

There were no Eastern Mail yet, it will probably be two days before the Railroad will be fully repaired.

CHOLERA IN NEW YORK. New York, July 11. At New York 85 cases of Cholera, and 30 deaths in this city today.
