

CONSTITUTION

COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

WE, The People of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, do hereby establish this Constitution...

ARTICLE I. The legislative power of this Commonwealth shall be vested in a General Assembly...

Section II. The representatives shall be chosen annually by the citizens of the Commonwealth...

Section III. No person shall be a representative who shall not have attained the age of twenty-one years...

Section IV. Within three years after the first meeting of the General Assembly, and within every subsequent term of seven years, an enumeration of the taxable inhabitants shall be made...

Section V. The senators shall be chosen for three years by the citizens of the Commonwealth...

Section VI. The number of senators shall, at the several periods of making such enumeration, be fixed by the Legislature...

Section VII. The senators shall be chosen in districts, to be formed by the Legislature...

Section VIII. No person shall be a senator, who shall not have attained the age of thirty years...

Section IX. The General Assembly may be elected at the first general election after the adoption of the amendments to the constitution...

Section X. The General Assembly shall meet on the first Tuesday of January, in every year...

Section XI. Each house shall choose its Speaker and other officers; and the Senate shall also choose a Speaker pro tempore...

Section XII. The qualifications of the members of the General Assembly shall be determined by a committee...

Section XIII. Each house may determine the rules of its proceedings, punish its members for disorderly behaviour...

Section XIV. The Legislature shall not have power to enact laws annulling the contract of marriage in any case...

Section XV. Each house shall keep a journal of its proceedings, and publish them weekly, except secrets...

Section XVI. The doors of each house and of committees of the whole shall be open, unless the business shall be such as ought to be kept secret...

Section XVII. Neither house shall, without the consent of the other, adjourn for more than three days...

Section XVIII. The Senators and representatives shall receive a compensation for their services...

Section XIX. No Senator or representative shall, during the term for which he shall have been elected, be appointed to any civil office...
