

CONSTITUTION

COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AS AMENDED BY THE CONVENTION OF ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-EIGHT.

WE, The People of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, ordain and establish this Constitution for the Government.

ARTICLE I. The legislative power of this Commonwealth shall be vested in a General Assembly, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives. Section I. The representatives shall be chosen annually by the citizens of the city of Philadelphia...

Section II. The representatives shall be chosen annually by the citizens of the city of Philadelphia and of each county respectively on the second Tuesday of October. Section III. No person shall be a representative who shall not have attained the age of twenty-one years...

ARTICLE II. The executive power of this Commonwealth shall be vested in a Governor. Section I. The Governor shall be chosen on the second Tuesday of October, by the citizens of the Commonwealth...

ARTICLE III. The judicial power of this Commonwealth shall be vested in a Supreme Court, in a Court of Appeals, in County Courts, in the Justices of the Peace, and in such other courts as the Legislature may from time to time establish.

ARTICLE IV. The powers of the Governor shall be as follows. Section I. He shall be commander-in-chief of the army and navy of this Commonwealth, and he shall have the power to pardon offences against the laws...

Section II. He shall have the power to grant reprieves, commutations, and pardons, and to remit fines and forfeitures, subject to the provisions of any law which may be enacted by the Legislature...

Section III. He shall have the power to nominate and to appoint, and to remove, all officers and ministers of justice, and all officers of the civil service, and all officers of the militia...

Section IV. He shall have the power to grant commissions to officers of the militia, and to receive and receive the oaths of office from all officers and ministers of justice, and all officers of the civil service...

Section V. He shall have the power to call upon the militia, and to receive and receive the oaths of office from all officers and ministers of justice, and all officers of the civil service...
