Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same passed the 2d day of February, 1802. And it is enjoined on me to give due and public notice of such election to be held for the purpose aforesaid, as follows: I, PETER F. LUDWIG, High Sheriff of Schuylkill County, do therefore hereby make known a general notice to the Electors of the said county of Schuylkill that an Election will be held in the said county by the citizens qualified to vote for members of the General Assembly, at the same places at which the last preceding election, on the 5th of January, 1802, was held, to wit: on the 30th day of October next, for the purpose of electing 30 Electors of a President and Vice President of the United States and the several Inspectors, Clerks and Tellers of the said County.

And it is further enacted, that as soon as all the votes shall be read off and counted, the Judges of each district shall make out a certificate, signed by the said Judges or a majority of them, of the number of votes which have been given for each candidate; which number shall be expressed in words, length, and one of the said Judges shall take charge of said certificate and on the Monday next, (which will be the second day of said month), produce the same in a meeting of one of the Judges from each district at the Court House in the Borough of Orwigburg, when and where the said certificates shall be read off and counted, and a return for the whole district, and make out triplicate returns, signed by the said Judges &c.
