In Massachusetts, soiling has been followed for many years. The Hon. Josish Quincy says: 'At _ the end of the soiling season firum June to November, I had \$200 worth of manure, and kepi 20 " head of cattle on a acres; by pasturing, I had to

stock in fine condition, a full supply of milk all the season, saved all expense on cross fences, not requiring one rod of interior fence on my farm. while previously, I had 1600 rods, and paid \$60 yearly f r repairs. The additional expense I had sone to in cutting the food, in soiling, amounted to \$163. My manute alone paid for this. I have practiced soiling for six years and no consideration would induce me to abandon 🛃

On the farm of McLean Asylum (Charlestown,) thirteen cows and seven horses are keit, although the land under cultivation is only 20 acres; and yet hay is sold. M. G. E. Adams. of Medford, soils his stock, being convinced of its great superiority over pasturing.


Mr. Newhall of Dorchesters also keeps a large

stock on the soiling system. I think the introduction of soiling cannot but be attended with immense advantages.

I would draw the attention of farmer- to the ad-mirable soiling qualities of Licerne. This plant. s perfectly adapted to this climate-cuts 4 or 5 times every season; stands the winter better than clover; is ready for cutting in the spring earlier than any other grass, and give excellent milk. It has been cultivated in New York for some years, though its introduction is as yet rather limited.

HORING POTATOES .- We hope that farmers will make experiments in hoeing potatoes and see if there be any advantages in the bar bar ound in potatoes, or to determine, wether it be not labor-worse than useless. Why should the water bedrained from plants that require much moisture, in a climate, too, that is generally dry, far too dry for this vegetable. If any hill be made, it should be made higher on the outside leaving a cavity for the water, instead of making it in a cone-like form, to throw of the water like the roof of a buil-

ding. We have raised the largest crops of potatoes without hills and in some cases there was not earth enough over the potatocatic cover them when they attained a full growth. Will farmers make experiments in hosing and report to us the results 1 Hoe some rows by destroying the weeds loosening the earth and allowing it to remain land. Make broad hills around other rows with a concave surface so that the water will rup to the roots of the plants. The most economical mode, is to plant as we lately reccommended se that there will be a. eavity to hold the water, and evitivate without filling it up.-Bonon Cultivator.


