As soon as the earth is made wet enough for any chemical decomposition to take place, the oxalic acid must let go its base of iron or alumnia, and seize upon and combine with the lime that formed an ingredient of the gypsum. The subhuric acid left free will combine with the iron or the alumnia of. the 47soil, forming coppers in the one case, and alum in the other. The gypsum no longer existsand surely no more satisfactory reason can be given why no effect from it should follow. The decomposition of the gypsum has served to form two or perhaps three other substances. One of them, oxalate of lime, I suppose to be highly valuable as manure; but the very small quantity that could be formed out of one or even two bushels of gypsum, could have no more visible effect on a whole scre, than that small quantity of calcareous earth or farm-yard manufe. The other substance certainly formed, copperas, is known to be a poison to the soil and to plants - and alum, of which the formation would be doubtful, I belive is also hurtful. . Soils that are naturally calcareous, cannot contain oxalic acid combined with any other base than lime. Hence gypsum applied there, continues to be gypsum, and exerts great fertilizing power.' BEAUTIFUL EXPERIMENT -- Colors of Flowers and Plants changed by placing their Stem vestigations on the chemical forces of plants and the circulation of the sap, we made some experi-ments, for the purpose of seeing how far the color of flowers was dependent upon the various salts contained in the earth, and which are taken up by the forces which convey the sap. . We took a beautiful white rose, placed the stem of it in a solution of the yellow prussiate of potash. let it remain there for four or five hours. Wo then placed it in a solution of sulphate of iron, where it remained until morning. On examining it the next morning, we found the petals changed to a delicate primrose color, the leaves to a dark blueish green, and the wood of the stem to a deep blue. The veins in the petals were also of a deep blue color. The fragrance of the flower remained unchanged, and it looked as fresh as one that was plucked at the same time. and which had been kept in a vase of water. The rationals of these singular changes seems to be as follows : The prussiate of potash is taken up by capilliary attraction, and distributed through every, part of the plant. The same is the case with the sulphate of iron. As soon as the two solutions are brought in contact, the iron acting as a re-agent, revives the prussian blue, which forms the base of prussiste of potash. This beautiful experiment can be tried by any one, care being taken that the solutions are not too strong. The effects noted above will not take place, if the solutions are mixed in a vessel before using .---The experiment may be varied by using any metalic solutions, the resulting colors of course depending upon the salts made use of .-- Cincinnati Atlas.
