

The Coal Trade for 1846.

The few cold nights has caused an increased demand for coal for household purposes, and the quantity sent this week reaches 28,561 1/2 tons, being an increase of about 1200 tons over last week's supply.

The white ash regions on the Lehigh are also being mined, the supply being in great part from the 3000 tons from that quarter.

The increase over the shipments of last year to the present period, is only about 170,000 tons, in round numbers. When we take into consideration the diminution of the supply for the last few weeks, the interest of the shipping season, and the certainty that the canal will not be coal business this fall, we feel convinced that all the coal that can be sent to market will be required, and, consequently, prices cannot recede any further this year.

We are now sending less weekly than we were last year at this time, and the facilities of the Rail Road will not permit a supply of more than 1,200,000 tons from the region during the year. The weekly supply from the Lehigh and Lackawanna regions is not greater at present than it was last year—so that the supply cannot be largely increased for the balance of the season this year.

The retail price of Coal is estimated to be 25 cents per ton in Philadelphia. Vendors are generally selling at Richmond, at prices steady, at the following quotations:
