FROM WASHINGTON. The Visitors in Washington have formed themselves into a committee, representing every State in the Union, to wait on Gov. Kosuth and present him with resolutions, expressive of their sympathy and respect for his personal and the principles he advocates.

KOSUTH IN WASHINGTON. Gov. Kosuth was introduced into the Senate on Monday, by the Committee appointed for that purpose. Mr. Shields, the chairman, simply saying, "We introduce Louis Kosuth to the Senate of the United States." The Senators rising, the President of the Senate bid him welcome, and invited him to a seat immediately in front of the Secretary's desk.
