PROFESSION VS. PRACTICE.

A few days ago we wrote of the Nebraska bill.

That is a feature of Douglas' Nebraska Bill, that deserves especial note, as showing the wide difference between the professions and the practicals of the engineers and bankers of the mechanical movement; namely, the clause excluding them from the right of suffrage in the organization of the State Government.

The friends of this Bill have spent their main strength in trying to convince its opponents and the country at large, that the repeal of the Missouri Compromise would enlarge the opportunities and privileges of the mechanicals; but, when they, except themselves, are to be excluded from the introduction of Slavery, naturally leaving it to the arbitrary discretion of Congress, this has been the theme for a continual topic ever since the first sign of the object. This is the profession, not what is in the practice.

In the Senate, a provision was engrossed upon it, which did not, when proposed, fit friends, sufficient to be done by—when no edition of birth in the territories in question, however long it may have been a resident, who has not seen Nature's unvarnished picture—it matters not what his intentions are in respect thereto—should have any say in the framing of the Slave government under which he is to live. This is a direct deviation from the established custom in all similar cases previously, and it is equally without excuse as is the practice.

This is the mood of sympathy and affection such as Douglas & Co., entertain for our emigrant population. In their Bumcombe speech Congress and all at home, the stumps, they cannot express devotion enough for these people; but when it comes to making laws for them, where their respective interests are antagonistic, very different story is told. They proclaim the democratic doctrine of legislating for the greatest good of the greatest number, but talk precious genteel in the "greatest number" shall provide No. 1.

The secret of this whole proceeding, is simply this, the engineers who seek a home on our western frontier are almost wholly pro-slavery, and the great general reason for human slavery; and they are to be found in Nebraska and Kansas or in other Territories about to become States in the Union, in the determination of their engineering organizations, it would suffice to use the first principles of Schaff's Political Philosophy for the expression of the "peculiar institution."
