BOSTON RIOT
All Boston has been in a turmoil of excitement since the late riot, in connection with the arrest and confinement of an alleged anarchist, known as William Walker, by a Mr. Tuttle of Virginia. Claimants were made at Faneuil Hall by Wendell Phillips, Rev. Mr. Parker and others, whereupon an individual attempt was made to break into the Court House and riotous proceedings in which one of the U. S. Marshal's police was killed. A large military force was sent to the scene to prevent further violence.

Next Monday, the County School Superintendant, to be chosen throughout the Commonwealth, in accordance with the provisions of the new law. The Directors of the several districts in this County, will meet in Thompson's Hall, corner of Market and Second Streets, at 10 o'clock, for that purpose. They have doubtless considered the importance of this new office, and it is therefore to be expected that they will discharge their duty with an eye single to the best interests of the Schools, over which they stand as guardians for the public.

He must be a man of "literary and scientific acquirements," and of "high and extensive attainments in the art of teaching," besides which, he should be a man of "high moral character, and of high repute in the community, and of high standing in the profession of the person to whom the office is conferred, and who, without this cannot be commissioned.
