Mr. Fowler's Declaration. A dispatch
from Washington, to the New York Dispatch,
states that there is reason to believe that
the Postmaster General Brown was aware of
the derangement in the accounts of Mr.
Rowler, but that he charged that his defalcation
was covered under the Pierce Administration
and, because there was an uncertainty
as to the settlement, he was not
sent to Charleston, with this large balance
under his hand. The fact was, a
copy of public notoriety for which no justifi-
cation can be found. As there is a desire
to conceal the proper information, Mr.
Rowler's committee will institute a full
inquiry. The subject was moved before them
last Tuesday evening. It is doubtful if
Mr. Rowler will cover half his obligation
to the public.

CONGRESSMAN FURNISHING TESTIMONY.
The New York Express, testifies
that Mr. Currier's Committee that
he had been appointed by the District
Attorney of the last Congress, \$500
per month for four months for \$2,000,
and for \$1,000, both of which were
paid in installments. Did not ex-
plain why he was not paid, and
arrangements were made. His evidence
