The populace took the Royal Palace from the troops and burnt it. The Chinese reply to the English ultimatum is published. It rejects all the propositions.

DEMOCRATIC ELECTIONS.—The Democratic Committee has ascertained that some six thousand fraudulent naturalization papers were issued in Philadelphia. The names and addresses of the persons who issued them were printed in Philadelphia. Most of the papers were issued to persons professing to have come to the United States before 1850 years ago, which did not require them to file a declaration of intention, and may serve as a means of detection.

THIS WEEK THE HON. WM. MONTGOMERY OF PENNSYLVANIA, was summoned before the Co-vent Committee to explain various statements of speeches by him, alleged that the President had offered him the best office in his gift to leave his country, and that he had declined it, and the like, but he failed either to refer himself, at the request of the Committee, to other members, or to obey a subpoena, though several times served.

THE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEES.—On Tuesday last Mr. Kears, of Reading, appeared before the Co-vent Committee, and testified that he was a contractor on the Union canal extension, and employed about 150 Irishmen. He had spent in his large number of the naturalization papers, alleged to be fraudulent, which were procured from R. M. Brown, an employe of the "New York Herald," and confessed some of these "useless" blanks to Democratic members. Some two or three hundred of these papers were circulated through Pennsylvania; some bearing the seal of a prothonotary who was now dead, and others in blank. Beautiful exposures these, truly.

TRASK'S NEW YORK TRIBUNE publishes that "private letter" from Mr. Greeley to Mr. Seward dated Nov. 11, 1854. Still we can do nothing in it, but what Mr. Greeley had a perfect right to do, sever his political connection, personally, with Mr. Seward, on any ground he saw proper. Men in this country are presumed to see why Mr. Greeley should have been so indiscreetly associated with a man at the head of the party, "in utter disregard of personal considerations."
