A PRETENDED COMPROMISE REVEALED. The Democratic State Committee held a meeting in Philadelphia, on Monday, to try to patch up some kind of a Union or joint electoral ticket. They say they agreed to recommend all forms of votes for one elector, and that they should carry the electors and the votes would elect Douglas in the electoral college, then they should vote for Douglas; if they would elect Breckinridge then they should vote for him. If these votes would elect either neither Douglas or Breckinridge, in that event there is no provision made. This lame attempt to patch up the wreck caused by the "irrepressible conflict" between the two factions of the Democratic party, has been exposed by the Philadelphia Herald of Freedom.

THE COAL TRADE. Rottsville, July 7, 1899. The quantity sent by Railroad this week in 1899, was 10,514 tons for the corresponding week last year. The shipment has fallen off the 4th of July, but at year the tolls were advanced on the 1st of July and the quantity sent to market the week after the advance was light. This year an advance will take place on the 15th inst. to 15 cents per ton. Next week, of course, the shipment will be light, and the price will be advanced for a week or two, until prices are arranged. On the 1st of September another advance of 15 cents per ton is advertised to take place, making an advance of 30 cents per ton in transportation and handling charges for the year.
