THE GREAT NAVAL EXPEDITION.

Entire Success.

The New York Tribune of Thursday, concluded full

accounts from its correspondents of the success of the great Naval expedition, a topic which engrosses the attention of all, filling every paper with narration and description.

We regret that our limited space precludes the possibility of giving the full reports and graphic narratives of the glorious fight and victory at Fort Royal. We will, however, give a summary of the events which there transpired.

After undergoing dire peril by the assault of the winds and waves, our small fleet first Royal Monitor, Nov. 4, and very soon received the compliment of a noisy attack from the "Moshon" fleet under Commodore Talbot. Forty-five minutes elapsed, however, to elicit the broadside of hard-wood and his contemptible squadron entered a hiding place.

On Tuesday another attack was made by this villainous fleet of Rebels to annihilate the Great Expedition, and for two hours there was shooting. Then three or four of our gunboats being fired of this fleet, opened fire side by side upon Talbot, whom many scattered away for the last time, and dispersed in any hole which opened to them. On Wednesday there was no fighting.

The decisive battle and consequent victory took place on Thursday, Nov. 7. At the mouth of Port Royal.

Two forts, Beaufort and Winkler, of many of our vessels as well as several hundred to employ, began at 9 o'clock morning the assault.

Fort Walker, on Hilton Head, mounted 22 guns; Fort Beaufort, on Big Point, 12.

Both these batteries returned our fire, but the "Talbot" refused to be subdued.

The battle began at twenty-sixty minute past nine in the morning, and at half past two in the afternoon the National flag was planted on the soil of South Carolina.

It was greeted by the shouts of thousands of patriots and saluted by strains of jubilant music from the various bands of the fleet.

Surgeon, the 5th of Connecticut, was pat on the shoulder by the possession of Fort Walker, over which the stars and stripes were flying. They rallied to their work, and secured a watery grave for themselves.

At 10 A.M. the fort was captured, and was useless.

At 11 A.M. the rebels surrendered, and the fort was given up to the victors.
