EVER solicitous to render his MUSEUM
still more and more an object of rational
entertainment, and subservient to the in-
terests of useful science, has on the in-
struction and with the advice of a number of
his friends, provided a Book, which will
be always open for the inspection of those
who visit his Museum, in which book it is
proposed to insert all such discoveries, in-
ventions, improvements, schemes, obser-
vations, experiments, projects, hints or
queries relating to the arts or science, as
any of his visitors, or correspondents, may
from time to time communicate.

Such as may chuse to conceal their names
may either send their communications an-
onymous, or at their desire, C. W. Peale
will insert their names, with the number or
signature of their respective communica-
