A nett deduction of five per cent, will be made to defray rite necessary expences of printing, &c. and the surplus will be made a part of the sund intended for the National University, to be erected within the City of Washington.

The drawing will be under the management of 24 gentlemen approved by the commissioners for the City of Washington, for the time being, and asting on oath.
