COMMISSIONERS SALES.

WHEREAS, by an act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, passed the eleventh day of April, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, entitled "An act to raise and collect county rates and levies," it is directed, that, for the payment of the taxes due on unseated lands, and of the necessary costs thereon accruing, the Commissioners shall, under certain restrictions, issue their warrant, and make sale of the whole, or any part thereof: THIS IS THEREFORE TO GIVE NOTICE, that, unless the taxes for the year 1798, and the costs thereon arising, on the following described tracts of unseated lands, situate in the county of Westmoreland, be paid into the hands of JOHN BRANDON, Esq. Treasurer of said county, on or before the Fifteenth day of September next, they will be exposed to public sale, agreeably to the directions of the aforesaid act.
