Wilson) has despatched important in-structions to the United States Surveyor General at Bants Fe, New Mexico, respecting mines. Par-ties had presented to the Surveyor General papers claiming mining rights in vitre of "denounce-ment." The Commissioner refers to the mining system of oid Spain as transforring to Mexico after her separation from the parent country.
