refuse to reseive any compensation. Some of them ought to be reasonably paid for their services, and if I have the power, compensation will be made to them. In answer to interrogatories which I put to the Secretary of War, and which answers were con-tained in a former message to you, I learned from the War Department of the United States that the accounts of the Commissary and Quartermaster's Department of this State would be mainly reim-burged by the United States Government. To a large extent these claims have been already for-mally recognized by the officers of the National Government. And the accounts have been, and will be so kopt, and andited, as to establish their validity beyond all question.
