WASHINGTON, Wednesday, Nov. 25, 1863. The following official despatches from Major General Thomas and Major General Grant have been received at the headquarters of the Army...

CHATTANOOGA, Nov. 24, 1863. Major-General H. W. Halleck, Gen-in-Chief: Yesterday, at half past twelve o'clock, Gen. Sherman and Gen. Palmer's corps, supported by the Twenty-third Corps, advanced directly in front of Bragg's position...

CHATTANOOGA, Nov. 27, 1863. Major-General H. W. Halleck, Gen-in-Chief: I am just from the front. The rout of the enemy is most complete. Abandoned wagons, caissons, and occasional pieces of artillery are everywhere to be found...

CHATTANOOGA, Nov. 28, 1863. Major-General H. W. Halleck, Gen-in-Chief: The fighting to-day progressed favorably. Gen. Sherman carried the end of Missionary Ridge, and is now at the mouth of the Tennessee river...
