RAILROAD ACCIDENTS.—Under the act of March 28d, 1865, passed by the Legislature of Pennsylvania, to promote the safety of travelers on railroads, a brakeman has been convicted in Luzerne county of criminal negligence, and sentenced to imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for thirteen months.

THE LAW READERS' SUBSTANTIALLY AS FOLLOWS: If any person or persons in the service or employ of a railroad or other transportation company, doing business in Pennsylvania, shall refuse or neglect to obey any rule or regulation of such company, or by reason of negligence or willful misconduct shall fail to observe any precaution or rule which it is his duty to obey and observe, and injury, or death, to any person or persons shall thereby result, such person or persons shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, on conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding \$5000, and to undergo an imprisonment in the county jail or in the State penitentiary not exceeding five years.
