case of attempted poisoning in high life,
which has just come to light. The in-
tended victim was the Duc de Bauffremont,
a well preserved gentleman of
fifty, rich, distinguished-looking, and a
favorite in society; and this would-be
poisoner was a handsome young Polish
Count, Kaidulakowski by name, who had
conceived a passionate admiration for the
Duchesse de Bauffremont. Of a wealthy
and aristocratic family he was himself
most penniless, and seems to have lived
on his good looks and his reputation.
