PROCEEDINGS OF CONGRESS. WASHINGTON, March 8. In the Senate, Mr. Conkling introduced a bill, which was referred to the Finance Committee.

On motion of Mr. Sumner, the District of Columbia Equal Rights Bill, which had been killed at previous sessions, was again taken up and passed.

Mr. Hubert presented a constitutional amendment.

TELEGRAPHIC SUMMARY. Tuesday, March 9. Samuel Mac Millan, the defaulting Cavalier of the Fourth National Bank of Philadelphia, surrendered himself yesterday.

The death warrants of George S. Twitchell, Jr., and Gerald Eaton have been signed by Governor Henry. They are to be executed on Thursday, the 8th of April.
