GENERAL NEWS OF INDUSTRIES

Anthracite Freight Rates Are Reduced From the Mines to Buffalo.

It Has Already Been Inaugurated Between the Pennsylvania and the Lackawanna Systems and May Go Even Further If a Compromise Be Not Soon Reached—Today's Meeting of the Salesagents Is Fraught With Much Significance—Other News and Speculation Relating to Industries.

WAR IN RATES TO TIDEWATER

At their meeting Wednesday the freight agents of the anthracite system reduced the rates between the mines and Buffalo from \$2.35 to \$2.20. It is announced that further tide-water action was taken in rates to Tidewater, Lackawanna, it is said, adopted a fixed rate of \$1.45 on all sizes to go into effect April 1. This is against \$1.75 on prepared size, which has been in operation for a considerable time. Other roads did not announce their conclusion of a new rate, but it is possible they may soon do so. The Pennsylvania rate on the 40 per cent basis is \$1.61 on prepared size. The Lackawanna rate is made lower than the Pennsylvania rate and includes pea and buckshot sizes, which are not included in the Pennsylvania rate. The Lehigh Valley rate made a few weeks ago was 40 per cent on all sizes.

The question of restricting production appears as part of settlement of ship-ments of anthracite (approximately) for the week ending March 24 given below to be rigidly adhered to, the decrease in the tonnage for the three previous weeks for the period named having been 385,116 tons, making the total decrease for the year to date 2,977,712 tons.
