GENERAL NEWS OF INDUSTRIES

The general sales agents of the anthracite coal companies in New York Thursday decided to make no reduction in prices, either for the east or west. They also decided to restrict production during May to 2,500,000 tons, which is about 50 per cent. over their theoretical capacity.

It is understood that at the approaching annual election of the Delaware and Hudson Canal company the ticket for directors in the Olympian-Vanderbilt interest will contain the names of Vice President H. Walter Walsh, of the New York Central; Vice President J. W. Alexander, of the Equitable Life Assurance society, and H. G. Young, a successful member of the board of managers who are supporting the Le Grand Cannon ticket, in opposition to President Olympian.

Retail dealers in tinware do not find their business alike affected. The recent general strike of the miners, which has lasted up nine shipments in generally, cannot seriously affect small dealers for some time. Large dealers, or contractors, which now supply smelting furnaces and large manufacturers, will have sufficient cause to complain should the strike continue.

The Monongahela blast furnaces of the National Tube works company, at McKeesport, are both off duty. The furnaces closed down Thursday. Furnace "A" will be repaired, which will require an outlay of \$25,000. A scarcity of coke has necessitated the temporary banking of furnace "B." Very few men will be thrown out of work as the workmen will be employed tearing out the lining of furnace "A" and relining it. The work will require several weeks time.

Receiver William B. Bromall, of the Wellman Steel and Iron company, has ordered a complete shut down of that plant, to take effect today. The Wellman works in prosperous times employed over 1,200 men, but since the failure of the company and the appointment of the receiver, only portions of the immense works have been operated.

Minor Industrial Notes: A cargo of 3,100 tons of iron ore from St. Iago, Cuba, has been received at Baltimore, consigned to the Pennsylvania Steel company at Scranton. Bills for supplying the Boston and Maine railroad with 250,000 tons of bituminous coal will be opened by the general manager of the road at Boston today.
