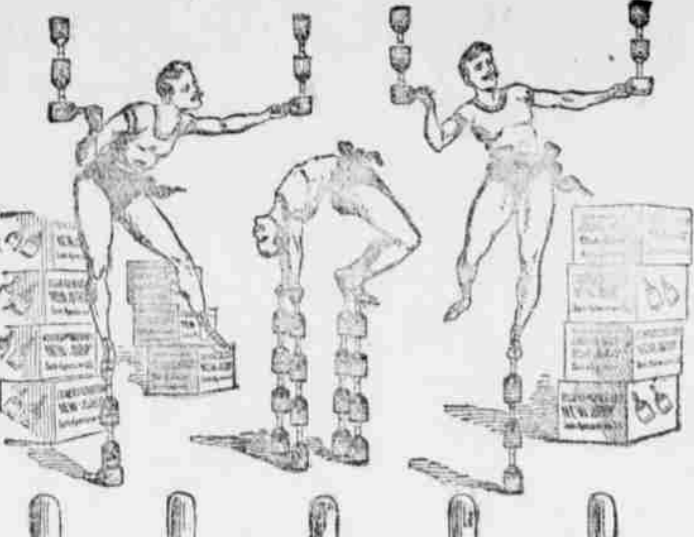

Everything now seems to point to a monster rate war among the trunk lines running from the Atlantic seaboard to the Mississippi. It may be averted, but the likelihood is small.

The meeting was mainly called to adopt \$10,000 penalty for violations, such as rate cutting, but as sixteen companies voted in favor of it, and fourteen against, and as the vote must be unanimous the penalty contract was lost.

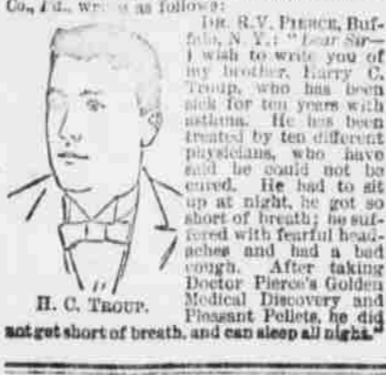
