

DAY IS WON

Democratic Host Is Vanquished.

THE END IS NOT YET

Senator Hill Snowed Under by Indignant Wage Earners, Who Have Had Enough of Bogus Promises Ne'er Realized.

TAMMANYISM IS WIPED OUT

So Is the Democratic Party--Republicans Elected by Large Majorities to Conduct the Affairs of New York State--Morton Has 175,000 Plurality and Strong Beats Grant by 75,000--Wilson Is Beaten in West Virginia.

A tidal wave of protection and clean government has won another decisive victory, beside which all its past victories have been insignificant. Hill is beaten by Morton in New York state by 75,000 plurality. Hugh J. Grant, the Tammany candidate for mayor in New York city, is defeated by Colonel William L. Strong, the anti-Tammany candidate, by 75,000 plurality. Goff, for recorder, wins by nearly 100,000 plurality; Morton carries Brooklyn and Kings county by 20,000, and every Tammany candidate for congress is snowed under, including gallant General Sikes, the valiant veteran who trains politically with a bad crowd.

In New Jersey the Republicans capture the legislature, insuring the election of a Republican to the United States senate in place of McPherson, Democrat.

In West Virginia, "Sir" William Wilson, the author of the new tariff, and the "member from Great Britain," is left at home by his alert antagonist, Colonel A. G. Dayton; and in order that he may not be too lonesome, the other three Democratic congressmen are defeated also.

"Bloody Bridges" Waite, Colorado's Populist governor, is tucked under a clean 18,000 Republican plurality, which also turns down eloquent Late Pence, of Denver.

At 9 o'clock Chairman Allen W. Thurman, of the Ohio Democratic committee, said: "The whole country seems to have gone to pot. There is but one bright spot apparent. South Carolina still stands Democratic. We have heard from only 155 precincts in Ohio, but that is enough. If it keeps up, the Republicans will carry the state by 150,000. It means that there will not be a Democratic congressman elected in Ohio. I think Oklahoma is defeated by at least 2,500."

Illinois goes Republican by 75,000, and elects a Republican legislature, which insures Senator Cullom's re-election. The Republicans in Illinois have elected sixteen congressmen. Springfield falls by the wayside. Indiana is safe by from 20,000 to 30,000, and shows a gain of six congressmen. The victory in Minnesota and Kansas is overwhelming. The whole free-silver west is once more back in line. And even proud old Virginia seems trembling on the brink of a political revolution. All in all, it was a noble victory, and the next congress will, at the present rate of gains, elect Tom Reed speaker by more than 50 majority.

THE RETURNS BY STATES.

Full Details of the Voting in Every American Commonwealth.

Elections were held yesterday in all the states except Maine, Oregon and Vermont, which held their elections earlier in the season. Below will be found the result of each election as far as known up to 3 o'clock this morning:

ALABAMA.

Montgomery, Nov. 6.—Alabama state officers were elected August 3. Today's election passed off quietly. The Democrats captured all of the nine congressional seats. Clarke defeated Wickham, B. and Sibley, P., in the First district; Stallings defeated Gardner in the Second; in

the Third General Harrison had little difficulty in disposing of the fusion candidate, W. C. Robinson; the Fourth, where two Democrats, Tom Plowman and Gaston Robbins, were running on separate tickets against a Populist and a Fusionist, has probably been carried by Plowman. Cobb is elected by a round majority in the Fifth; in the Sixth, Bankhead is overwhelmingly elected; Denon sweeps the Seventh, Wheeler the Eighth and Underwood the Ninth. The vote was light. Populists made large gains.

Little Rock, Nov. 6.—Arkansas elected state officers Sept. 3. Following are the congressional votes for today: First district—P. D. McCallough, Jr., D.; Second—M. C. CALIFORNIA.

Sacramento, Nov. 6.—California elected its full list of state officers, to serve four years, and the legislature, which will choose a United States senator to succeed Senator Leland Stanford, Republican. The people of California adopted upon this proposed amendments to their State constitution to establish an educational qualification for the suffrage; to empower the legislature to create new counties; to exempt from taxation fruit and nut trees under four years of age and grape vines under three years of age; to empower the legislature to provide for the disposition of coal lands now held by private individuals; to permit city and county governments to increase taxes under general laws; to reorganize the state board of equalization, making it consist of the auditor general and one member from each of the eight congressional districts; to provide for the exempt property used for free public libraries and museums from taxation; to add the president and professor of geology of the University of California to the state board of education; and to increase the term of membership in the legislature to three years for the session of 1895, the candidates for Governor were: James H. Budd, Democrat; Morris M. Eaton, Republican; J. A. Wadsworth, Populist; Henry French, Prohibitionist; Cleveland Deane, Independent; Harrison (Rep.), 18,927; Weaver (Pop.), 27,711. The congressional nominees were: First district—Thomas J. Geary, D.; J. H. Greaney, P.; J. A. Buchanan, R.; Second—Anthony Caminitto, D.; Grove L. H. Sowers, P.; R. 1. 18,927. The Republicans gain three congressional seats and elect the state ticket by increased pluralities.

COLORADO.

Denver, Nov. 6.—Colorado elected all its state officers, to serve two years, and the legislature, which will choose a United States senator to succeed Edward G. Wolcott, Republican. The people voted upon two proposed amendments to the constitution of the state, one of which allowed cities of over 25,000 inhabitants to incur indebtedness to the amount of 5 per cent of their assessed valuation, and the other provided for \$1,500,000 of bonds to take up old state securities, most of which are now held by the School Fund. The candidates for Governor were: Charles P. Jones, Democrat; George W. Wood, Republican; DAVIS H. WAITE, present incumbent, Populist; George Richardson, Prohibitionist. The vote for Governor in 1892 was: Democrat, 35,348; Republican, 28,620; Prohibitionist, 187. The congressional candidates were: First district—John F. Shaff, P.; Late Pence, P.; R. H. Rhodes, R.; P. B. Bolton, D.; Second—John C. Bell, P.; Thomas M. Bowen, R.; W. A. Rice, P.; Giles O. Pierce, P.; Third—John C. Bell, P.; Melville defeats Waite by 18,000. CONNECTICUT.

Hartford, Nov. 6.—Connecticut elected a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Treasurer, Controller, all for terms of two years, a Legislature, four Congressmen, eight County Sheriffs, all for terms of four years each, and 11 Judges of Probate for terms of two years. The candidates for governor were: E. Neal Tully, Democrat; Vincent Coffin, Republican; Charles C. Hingham, Fusionist; De Witt C. Pond, Prohibitionist; James P. Tuckey, Socialist-Labor. The vote for president in 1892 was: Democrat, 82,829; Republican, 79,928; Prohibitionist, 4,999. The congressional candidates were: First district—E. C.
