Justices of the Supreme Court Indulge in Speechmaking.

REMARKABLE BENCH SCENES

Dissenting Judges Deliver Flery Orations. Large Crowds of Interested Spectators—A Scene Without a Parallel.

Washington, May 20.—The supreme court today, through Chief Justice Fuller, announced its decision by a vote of 5 to 4 wiping the income tax law out of existence as unconstitutional.

The majority vote was cast by the chief justice and Justices Field, Gray, Brewer and Shiras, the latter having shifted his position since the former decision, and made the majority against the law. Then, for over two hours, the four dissenters, Harlan, Jackson, Brown and White, attacked the decision, one after the other, in opinions unprecedented in feeling and earnestness...
