MYSTERIOUS DEATH.

John Weinhart, of Stroudsburg, Dies from a Bullet Wound. About 8 o'clock on Saturday morning Patrolman Thomas found a man in a very weak condition near the corner of a street house. The man was very weak and said he had just come from Stroudsburg, and the officer saw that his forehead had been severely cut. The patrol wagon was called and the man taken to the hospital.

Officer Thomas meanwhile made inquiries at the Wilkes-Barre and East Stroudsburg hotels, but he had arrived in this city on the 5:30 passenger train, the trainman having picked him up at Stroudsburg, where they had found him in a partially helpless condition. He told the trainman that he had fallen off a bridge at Stroudsburg. His appearance substantiated this statement, as he had a ugly wound on his forehead. He said, however, that he had fallen off a bridge at Stroudsburg, and lay down by a tree. The trainman advised him to get up and go to the hospital and he started across the bridge.

Dr. Prevost examined him at the hospital and found to his surprise that the man was not only severely cut on the head, but that he had a bullet wound just over his heart. Just before he died the man gave his name as John Weinhart of Stroudsburg. He spoke with a German accent.

The following dispatch came from Stroudsburg: Stroudsburg, Nov. 2.—John Wyckoff, whose home is in Wilkes-Barre, fell off a bridge a mile below town last Sunday night. He pulled himself to a watchman's shanty and laid undiscovered until the last of the week. He was found by a man working on a Wilkes-Barre sewer. He is a Pole and by birth. We know nothing of the shooting.

The man was put aboard the Wilkes-Barre and Eastern train by Trackmaster Corcoran and one of the poor directors of Monroe county, who paid his fare to this city. He is now in the hospital and the bullet wound in his breast.

A post mortem was held, but the result was not to be given out until after the coroner's inquest. He was 5 feet 5 inches in height, and weighed 140 pounds, apparently about 40 years of age, and had a sandy mustache and a gray beard of several days' growth. He had a pipe in his pocket and a purse containing two cents. An effort will be made to discover the man's identity and the cause of the mysterious bullet wound.

HURT IN AN EXPLOSION.

Three Men Seriously Injured by Gas at the Pettobone Mine. Three men were badly hurt on Saturday by an explosion of gas at the Pettobone mine. They were Fred Rudiger, laborer, burned on the face and hands; William Ferry, miner; Brovery Hill, burned on face and hands. He is thirty-eight years old and married; and Arthur Abbot, laborer, burned on face and hands. He is a single man, twenty-two years of age.

They had been examining an old working when they encountered gas in such quantities that it was ignited by their lamps at the explosion followed. They were taken to the hospital, where they are under treatment. There is every hope of their recovery.
