### THE WORLD OF BUSINESS

**Wall Street Review.**  
New York, Feb. 18.—The movements on the Stock Exchange today were not particularly important. The transactions aggregated only 13,173 shares, but speculation was characterized by a very firm tone, the strength being attributable to purchases for London account, the success of the government loan and the prevailing belief that if any further restriction in favor of free silver is attempted it is sure to meet with a defeat.

In the early trading prices advanced 1 1/2 per cent. in the usually active list, Louisville and Nashville, The Grangers, Sugar, Manhattan and Tennessee coal and iron leading the upward movement. Among the specialties Louisville, New Albany and Chicago was prominent, the preferred rising to 2 1/2 and the common to 2 1/4. In the afternoon the traders became bearish and under their sales a reaction ensued, Manhattan fell to 1 1/2; Leather, Preferred, 6 1/2; Missouri Pacific to 2 1/2; Chicago Great West, 1 1/2; General Electric to 2 1/2 and the remainder of the list from 1/2 to one cent. Speculation less of late, but steady in tone at a recovery of 1/2 per cent. Sugar was noticeably firm owing to the reports that the directors will declare the usual dividend early in March and an extra dividend of 10 per cent. after the adjournment of congress. The heavy gain in the earnings of the St. Paul road for the second week of February had a favorable influence upon the market and induced purchases of all the trangers' stocks for both the long and short account. The largest dealings were: \$1000 shares of Sugar; 25,000 St. Paul; 10,000 Louisville and Nashville; 2,500 Missouri Pacific; and 2,500 Burlington and Quincy. Net changes show losses of 1/2 to 1 1/2 per cent. Manhattan leading.
