Nor should they ever refuse to ack- nowledge with contrite hearts their proneness to turn away from God's teachings, and to follow with sinful pride after their own devices. To the end that these thoughts may be quickened, it is fitting that on a day especially appointed, we should join together in approaching the throne of grace with praises and supplication. Therefore, I, Grover Cleveland, presi- dent of the United States, do hereby designate and set apart Thursday, the twenty-sixth day of the present month of November to be kept and observed as a day of thanksgiving and prayer throughout our land. On that day let our people forego	render thanks to the ruler of the uni- verse for our presevation as a nation and our deliverance from every threatened danger; for the beace that has dwelt within our boundaries; for our defense against disease and pes- tilence during the year that has passed; for the plenteous rewards that have followed the labors of our husbandmen, and for all other blessings that have vouchsafed to us. And let us, through the meditation of Him who has taught us how to pray, implore the forgive- ness of our sins and a continuation of heavenly favor. Let us not forget on this day of thanksgiving, the poor and needy; and by deeds of charity let our offerings of praise be made more acceptable in the sight of the Loyd. Winess my hand and the seal of the United States, which I have caused to be hereunto affixed.
