LIVE NEWS FROM THE CUBAN WAR

A Spanish Deserter's Story of Maceo's Movements. WEYLER'S TROOPS AT PINAR DEL RIO

Several Spanish Battalions Have Penetrated to the Interior of the Hills and Have Burned the Huts Occupied by the Insurgents.

Key West, Fla., Dec. 17.—Passengers by the steamer Olivette last night report that great uneasiness is felt in Havana on account of the uncertainty of Maceo's death.

There was the wildest kind of excitement on the dock last night when the news of Maceo's death was received.

REBELS AT MATANZAS. Indications point to rebel parties having entered the province of Matanzas. Their trails show the direction in which they have gone, and a Spanish deserter's story shows that they are still in the province.
