THE BLAME IS NOW PLACED ON ENGLAND

Germany Holds Lord Salisbury Responsible for Existing Conditions.

INFLUENCE OF QUEEN AND CZARINA

Victoria's Interference Has Without Doubt Had its Effect Upon the English Premier--The Turkish Troops in a Disorganized Condition--Provisions and Clothing Needed.

Berlin, March 14.--Should the coercive measures taken by the powers against Greece result in a general European war the initial blame, according to public and official opinion here, will fall upon England.

There are those behind the scenes who say that from the outset of the Greco-Cretan crisis, the pretended participation of the Salisbury government has been a blind, and that King George up to a late point in the diplomatic contest was led to believe that eventually the influence of Great Britain would square the situation in favor of Greece.
