Industries Staggered by the Decision of the Supreme Court.

RAILROAD EARNINGS INCREASING

Reports for the Quarter Have Been Encouraging-Voice of the House Made No Impression on Business. Market for Products Has Been Variable and Uncertain.

New York, April 2.-R. G. Dun & Co. say tomorrow in their weekly review of Trade: The markets are still waiting, some sagging downward and others recovering. There is much doubt as to the decision of the Supreme court against railroad combinations as an instrument for depressing stocks and yet the buying has prevented a decline exceeding one dollar per share and for trust stocks 20 cents.
