Short lengths of Ingrain or three-ply carpet make convenient rugs for many places. Finish the ends by fringing the carpet for six inches. Coarsely but-tonhole the fringe part with some of the ravelings and tie the fringe into make tassels and fasten them between the rug and the floor.

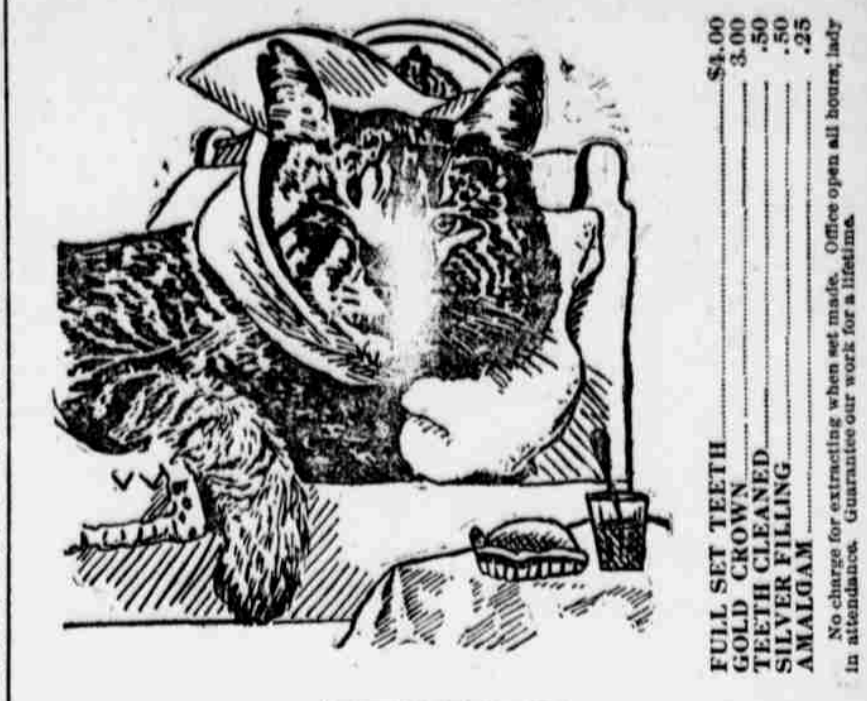
